In other words, the more people there are to give, the less everyone has to give in order to meet the budget. Others want to grow for reasons of prestige, so that we will be better than some other church. Still others wish to grow in order to have more programs to make us attractive to families with children. These and many others may be popular, but they are wrong!

So why do we want to grow? First and foremost, we grow because Jesus told us we are the light of the world. We are a city set on a hill, a light that is not to be hidden. Growth is the primary indicator that our light is shining. It means that we are proclaiming Christ's love to this world, which desperately needs to hear it. When we shine Christ's light, we remember that in everything we do, the Father in Heaven is to be glorified! This may sound simple, but how many of us are doing it?

Friends, we are part of a blessed family under Christ called Spring Branch Presbyterian. By grace, we are children of God. In response to that grace, let's be motivated to grow by the desire to hear the voice of God's creation, giving God glory. Let us pray, not only for cooler temps, but also for the rain of God's Spirit to water us deeply for true growth.




The "Mission of the Month" for August is MAM (Memorial Area Ministries). MAM was started in 1981 as a coalition of 14 local churches and one synagogue to establish a network to provide emergency services to families living in poverty. Today, over 30 congregations provide financial and other support to MAM.

MAM provides a wide array of services to the community, which now includes (Spring Branch, Cypress and Alief).

Services provided include: financial assistance programs, citizenship classes, employment services, English instruction, immigration assistance, mental health counseling, after school and immunization programs, and special targeted programs.

Our church will be collecting funds for MAM to provide school uniforms for children during the month of August. MAM's 2022 goal is to provide \$50 uniform vouchers to 5,000 children. Donations will be accepted in the breezeway before and after the service every Sunday, and donations may be dropped off in the church office. August Mission Updates & Opportunities

Hurricane Kits – On Sunday, July 3rd, 100 hurricane kits were packaged out our 4th of July Picnic. Thank you to everyone who participated! The kits are being distributed to our neighbors in need on August 13th.

PCHAS Back-To-School Supplies – Our church is a big supporter of PCHAS (Presbyterian Children's Home and Services). During July, we had a Back to School Drive to provide school supplies for the children involved with PCHAS. Thanks to everyone who contributed, and way to go SBPC!

July Blood Drive Update – Thank you to everyone that participated in our July 24th Blood Drive. We had a great success with a total of 14 eligible donors for 13 units of whole blood, and one plasma donation.

Mission of the Church to Feed My Sheep: Hot Meals – Currently, SBPC delivers Hot Meals to 34 elderly who generally have mobility problems. These are indeed "hot" chicken lunches prepared by Pappy's Café and delivered by SBPC members on the 4th Saturday of each month, and they are so very appreciated. At various times of the year, other items are provided by the church. These have included Advent and Easter information, hurricane kits and Thanksgiving Pumpkin Bread. Time involved is two to three hours late Saturday morning. This only happens if we have drivers to deliver. Please consider helping with this mission by driving some Saturday. Young Adult Mission Project – The Young Adult Group is headed to Mo-Ranch for a self-run retreat, August 11th-15th! While on the trip, the group will be pre-packaging pet food for Animeals, the program through Interfaith Ministries of Greater Houston that delivers a one-week supply of pet food to Meals on Wheels recipients that have cats or dogs. The Mission Team is providing the funds to purchase pet food in Kerrville while on the trip. If you would personally like to sponsor a bag of pet food, monetary donations can be placed in the offering plate on Sunday, August 7th, with "young adult mission" in the memo line. 


