The "Mission of the Month" in April is Summerhouse Houston. Summerhouse was founded in 2011 by a mother, Donna Fruge, who has a daughter with an intellectual disability, named Summer. The family could not find the right next step for Summer after high school. They wanted Summer to stay connected with her community and continue to develop work, social, and life skills, so Summerhouse was created.

Summerhouse offers community-based day services and supported employment services that are driven by the interests, needs and strengths of those they serve.

Members of the day services spend time in the community doing activities of their choice including volunteering and participating in social activities, classes, and more.

Through the supported employment program, they support members and referrals through the Texas Workforce Commission to find competitive, integrated employment. Summerhouse also provides coaching to ensure long term success on the job.

Let's Grow in God



As we work our way through the Bible, the rest of 2023, the kids will be learning about Ruth, Hannah, Saul, David, Solomon, Elijah, Elisha, Job, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, and Isaiah.

Also, the kids are learning the names of the books of the Old and New Testaments through games and songs, as well as seeing the "Hand of God" in their lives and the lives of the people they are studying.



As the children hear a Bible story where the "Hand of God" is seen in their lives, a leaf is added to the "Hand of God" tree on the wall of the classroom – that includes the lives of each of the kids.

Children's Sunday School Class

It was a year ago that we began the Children's Sunday School Class, which meets on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of each month. The class is designed for elementary-age children, ages 5 to 10, and we have averaged six children attending each class throughout the year.

The kids have been learning about the stories in the Bible by having crafts, stories, games, and other fun activities.

We started with an introduction to the Bible before going through the stories of Genesis, i.e., Creation, Adam and Eve, Noah, Tower of Babel, Abraham and Sarah, Isaac and Rebekah, Jacob and Esau, and Joseph. We had lots to discuss about Moses from November through January before moving on to crossing the Jordan River with Joshua, Rahab, and the walls of Jericho tumbling down.



Clara Dikeman, Lily Earnest, Jayden Earnest, Kaylee Earnest, and Piper Dikeman build the walls of Jericho to walk around before blowing the shofars they made and watching the walls come tumbling down.

We could not have had these classes without some incredible help from so many people that have stepped up to lead the kids through these lessons. 
Chip Colvin's Send Off Concert May 7th at 2:00pm in the Sanctuary, with a reception to follow.


