Under the full sponsorship and authority of Spring Branch Presbyterian Church, we strive to operate under the



policies and guidelines of the church and its preschool ministry. The Academy has exceeded the previous year's attendance and continues to push for growth.

Kids grow out of clothes so fast that passing gently used items onto each other just makes sense. To support this mission of the church, Spring Branch Presbyterian Church will be holding a clothing swap with the participation of the parents of the Academy. SPBC will collect the items and coordinate this swap, as well as provide a space for parents to come and "shop" after they have donated the items. This event was a huge success in prior years, so let's do it again!

## March Mission Updates and Opportunities

**PCHAS Diaper Drive!** – PCHAS is in need of girl's diapers, size 1, 4, and 5, and pull ups. You can either bring them to the church to donate or order them online and ship them to their location at 5020 W. Bellfort Avenue, Houston, TX 77035.

We received some really good feedback and will be changing things up a little bit for the next one to create a more specific show time for younger families and older.
