

After graduating from Texas A & M, she attended the Presbyterian School of Christian Education in Richmond, VA where she received her MA in Christian Education. She then returned to Houston and served two churches, St. Thomas and Pines Presbyterian, working with children, youth, and adults. During that time, she received her certification as a Christian Educator and was trained as a spiritual director. In 2005, she felt God tugging on her heart once again and calling her to go deeper in pastoral ministry. She entered Fuller Theological Seminary as a part-time student and eight years later, graduated with her Master of Divinity. Barbara left Pines in February of 2020 after 31 years to give more time and care to her family and aging parents.
