

Lenten Fish Frys — In addition to St. Jerome, we have three other Catholic Churches in the Spring Branch area that host Friday Night Fish Fry's. **St. Cecilia** at 11720 Joan of Arc (just south of I-10 off of Bunker Hill) serves from 5:30-8:00, and has a standard Fish Fry Plate (\$12 for adults, \$10 for seniors, \$7 for kids under 10. Add shrimp for \$3/plate). **Our Lady of Czestochowa** at 1731 Blalock serves from 5:00-8:30 and has a Fish and Shrimp plate for \$15, with \$3 desserts. **St. John Vianney** at 175 Nottingham Oaks (west of Dairy Ashford off of Memorial) has various prices and meals. Their Shrimp Scampi is \$16 and is offered on March 22nd. You need to make a reservation online and pay online. There are a limited number of tickets at the door for \$20. They serve from 5:30-7:30. Some of the churches don't serve their Fish Fry during Spring Break, March 15th.

Worship: Spring Branch Presbyterian Church welcomes families of all ages and sizes. For families with young children, relax! God put the wiggle in all children (and adults), we understand. You are invited to sit closer to the front so your children can hear, see, and experience worship with those around them. Remember, children and youth learn through what they observe. Participate and engage yourselves fully.

Nursery: Infants six weeks through Pre-K are welcomed in the nursery during worship. Kindergarten and older children will attend worship with their parents. The Church Nursery is available from 9:15 AM through shortly after Worship in the Bears classroom, Room 126, which is in the north hallway of the Education Building.

Sunday Morning Offerings at 9:30 am

Saints Under Construction: This class meets in the Sanctuary in the Garden Room. This discussion -oriented class focuses on what each of us can learn from the weekly Bible scriptures to build upon in strengthening our faith. Patti Nanney leads the class.

The class is designed for elementary-age children, ages 5 to 10, but all are welcomed.

Children's Chime Choir: The Chime Choir meets in the Sanctuary on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of each month. This is a chance for elementary aged children to get to ring chimes as part of Worship. We are excited to continue this new adventure! Megan Hogg leads the Chime Choir.

Other Faith Development Opportunities: Watch the monthly PresPress, weekly church-wide emails, and the worship bulletin for other opportunities throughout the year. It may be a short-term Special Topic or book discussions on Sunday mornings, a week night book study, or retreat.
