From the desk of Pastor Mark...

One of the most wonderful people who was in my life for many, many years was my Grandaddy. He was an amazing man who did many unusual and interesting things in his life. He was also one of the best storytellers I ever knew. He would tell stories about things he had seen or people in our family who had done some unusual things, or what it was like to live in the years way before me. I always listened because he was a good storyteller – but also because I was interested in what he had to say.

One thing I never heard him talk about (and I never asked him either!) was what happened to his left hand. For my entire life, Grandaddy's left hand was not the same as his right hand. He was missing half of his thumb, most of his index finger, and his middle finger would not bend very much. My mother explained to me that his hand had been badly injured in an accident when he was a little kid.

Yet, none of that stopped Grandaddy from being a pretty handy carpenter, painter, and worker who could do just about anything around the house. It also didn't stop him from being really good at his favorite game – golf. He would often beat his friends, his older brother who was a golf pro, and anyone else who played with him. Several times he got a hole-in-one, or shot his age (when he turned 70, he declared that maybe it would get easier to do that). He could also take the hand of any child who wanted to go for a walk without being sensitive or embarrassed about his lack of fingers.

I never heard him complain once... not a single time. In fact, he rarely complained about anything – except bad weather.

He was also a man of God whose faith was an inspiration to everyone who knew him. He didn't push his faith on anyone – he just lived his life and set a wonderful example for everyone who cared to take a close look.

Whenever I think of him, I remember a quote from 1st Thessalonians: "In everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

Grandaddy could have complained a lot about many bad things that happened during his life. But he never did. And his left hand always reminded me not to complain either. Instead, I need to give thanks like my beloved Grandaddy did!

There will be some games, but you are welcome to bring your own to share.






Come join the fun and get to know some people you may not know yet!




