Missions of the Month



The “Mission of the Month” for August is Memorial Assistance Ministries (“MAM”). Since 1982, MAM has been dedicated to helping those in the Spring Branch area by providing resources such as basic needs for those in poverty, employment services assistance, financial empowerment, and disaster relief assistance. Their mission is to build stable families, a dynamic workforce, and vibrant communities together. MAM has long been one of our church’s benevolences that we help support through our annual budget.

Our Mission Team’s focus for August is their Back-to-School Uniform Drive. This annual program helps parents shop for new uniforms for their children, because **all children** deserve to have a great back-to-school experience! Starting the year with new clothes helps children feel confident to greet their friends and focus on their studies. MAM takes our monetary donations and distributes more than 3,000 gift cards to local schools for children who need school clothes. Parents are then able to shop with their kids at local retailers.

MAM Back-to-School Uniform Voucher Drive – SBPC is once again collecting funds throughout the month of August for the Memorial Assistance Ministries (MAM) Back to School Uniform Voucher Drive. MAM coordinates with school guidance counselors and local vendors to provide school uniforms for local needy families. Mission Yahweh XL Sheets Drive – The Mission recently received a donation of 130 new XL Twin beds, so they have been asking for sheets to fit them. 



Finding Resilience, Joy, and Our Identity in Jesus Christ

Suggestions for Leaders by Joyce MacKichan Walker

In this Bible study, we will explore resilience. This is modeled for us by several biblical characters, gospel and epistle writers, as well as Jesus. So, what exactly is resilience?

Resilience is the ability to spring back into shape and to adapt well in the face of adversity, trauma, tragedy, threats, or stress—such as from family, relationships, health, workplace, and financial stressors. People who survive and thrive well in change are resilient.

The Bible study is also about joy. How do we find joy in a chaotic world? Christian joy may be different from how a lot of people define joy.

Joy is sometimes confused with happiness. For Christians, joy can occur while we are in the midst of difficult circumstances. Joy is the second fruit of the spirit, preceded by love and followed by peace. [Gal. 5:22-23] Trusting in God when we are in trying times can fill us with glorious joy and peace. We have joy in our suffering, because ultimately our joy is found in Jesus Christ.

We will also seek to rediscover our identity.

Identity is more than who we are or who we show ourselves to be. At its core, it points to our humanity. Our core identity is not found in our titles, our positions, our spouses, our partners, or our possessions. For Christians, our identity is found in Jesus Christ.



Wednesday Night Supper September 3rd — Hamburgers!



HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS



The International District would like to remind everyone that Hurricane Season is upon us. We all need to be smart and plan ahead for all kinds of disasters: natural, man-made, technological and terrorist related. In Southeast Texas, however, the most likely disaster scenario is a Hurricane.

BEFORE THE HURRICANE

- Monitor local TV or AM 740 KTRH
- Check supplies; especially water
- Fuel Vehicles & Generators
- Cover Windows with Plywood
- Bring in all objects that could become missiles
- Take pictures of property & contents for insurance purposes

DON'T FORGET THE PETS!

Pet disaster kits should include: medications, first aid kits, sturdy leashes and collars, carriers to transport pets safely, current photos with owner or family members, food, potable water, litter/pan, muzzle, can opener, and toys.

Make a check list of necessary pre-hurricane preparations and review with your family. Review it again when there is a storm in the Gulf. Discuss evacuation plans with your family.

Check Radio 740 and local television media for updates on zones being evacuated.

Make sure your home insurance policy is current and remember that standard policies may not cover flood/ wind damage.
