From the desk of Pastor Mark...

I come from a very long line of Presbyterian pastors and missionaries, and I know some pretty good stories about many of them. One of my favorites is my great-great Uncle William Junkin.

He and his wife, Aunt Nettie, and their two daughters, served as missionaries in China for almost 50 years. They returned to the United States once a year to raise funds and to collect donations of clean used clothes for the Chinese children.

Although Uncle Will and his family were doing the Lord's work in China, they didn't have it easy. They lived among some of the poorest people in the world. They lived and worked in China as the country transitioned from a fading empire with a child emperor, to a weak corrupt republic, to a captive population conquered by Japan during World War II, and finally, as refugees during the Chinese Civil War that ended with a Communist victory in 1949.

When Mao Zedeng and his Communists finally conquered China, Chiang Kai-shek and his Nationalists fled to the island of Formosa and established the Republic of China. There, Uncle Will and his family found themselves in 1949. Not too many years after this, Uncle Will and Aunt Nettie returned to the United States for good.

But the years had been hard on Uncle Will's health. To make things worse, there was no pension for missionaries in those days; most either died in their assigned countries or returned home and became parish pastors in the twilight of their lives. Unfortunately, Uncle Will only lived a year or two after becoming the pastor of a small church in the United States.

One question begs to be asked: **Do you think Uncle Will and Aunt Nettie were treated fairly by the Lord they served so faithfully for most of their lives?**

It is a tough question to answer! On the one hand, they had to struggle daily to bring the Good News to the Chinese people – often with government officials trying to discourage them; on the other hand, they loved the Chinese people and were loved by them in return. They worked joyfully and peacefully bringing the Good News to the people every day they were in China.

And if you were to ask that question of Uncle Will, I think he would become very upset that the question was even asked! They were joyful servants of the Lord God; what more could they ask for? Personally, I hope to meet them in Paradise someday.

NEW Adult Bible Study and Fellowship Gathering


Immediately following Wednesday Night Supper on 9/10/2025





HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS



The International District would like to remind everyone that Hurricane Season is upon us. We all need to be smart and plan ahead for all kinds of disasters: natural, man-made, technological and terrorist related. In Southeast Texas, however, the most likely disaster scenario is a Hurricane.

BEFORE THE HURRICANE

- Monitor local TV or AM 740 KTRH
- Check supplies; especially water
- Fuel Vehicles & Generators
- Cover Windows with Plywood
- Bring in all objects that could become missiles
- Take pictures of property & contents for insurance purposes

DON'T FORGET THE PETS!

Pet disaster kits should include: medications, first aid kits, sturdy leashes and collars, carriers to transport pets safely, current photos with owner or family members, food, potable water, litter/pan, muzzle, can opener, and toys.

5 GALLONS OF WATER, PER PERSON, PER DAY.

STOCK EMERGENCY SUPPLIES

>> *at least 72 hours worth* <<

- First Aid Kit
- NOAA Radio & Batteries
- Flashlight & Batteries
- Extra Eye Glasses
- Bottled Water & Non-perishable Food
- Clothing & Bedding
- Toilet Paper & Personal Hygiene Items
- Medications & Prescription copies
- Cash & Credit Cards
- Photo ID & Important Documents
- Baby & Elderly Necessities

Make a check list of necessary pre-hurricane preparations and review with your family.

Review it again when there is a storm in the Gulf. Discuss evacuation plans with your family.

Check Radio 740 and local television media for updates on zones being evacuated.

Make sure your home insurance policy is current and remember that standard policies may not cover flood/ wind damage.
