From the desk of Pastor Savannah Goodman...

Dear Spring Branch Presbyterian,

On Easter morning, we gather as people who know what it is to fail, falter, and fall short. And yet, we dare to proclaim, “Alleluia! Christ is risen!” because Easter is God’s declaration that our failures are not final, that sin does not have the last word, and that God’s love and grace are generous and eternal.

The apostle Paul writes in 2 Corinthians, “So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything old has passed away; look, new things have come into being!” (5:17). That is Easter language – resurrection language – second-chance language. And, it is not confined to a single Sunday. In the church’s calendar, Easter is an entire season – fifty days stretching from the empty tomb to Pentecost – an ongoing celebration of God’s renewing power at work among us.

We confess that we are saved by grace alone. We do not engineer our own resurrections. God acts first. God raises Jesus. God restores the broken. God grants second chances because that is who God is. Easter is God’s beautiful gift. And, this gift is meant to be lived the entire Easter season and beyond. The Easter season invites us to practice resurrection each day.

During these fifty days, we hear story after story of the risen Christ appearing, teaching, forgiving, and sending. Resurrection becomes a way of life. A forgiven people learn to forgive. A restored people learn to work for restoration. A hopeful people dare to embody hope in a world quick to cancel and slow to reconcile.

Easter Sunday is the spark. And, the Easter season is the steady flame. So, hear the good news: whatever regret, grief, or failure you carry – God’s grace is not exhausted. In Christ, you are granted a second chance. In Christ, we are being made new – not just today, but throughout this holy Easter season and into all the days ahead.

Alleluia. Christ is risen. The Lord is risen indeed! Alleluia!

SBPC Weekend Hot Meals

A very important mission of our church is to provide yummy, healthy meals to Spring Branch area seniors in need. Have you heard of *Meals on Wheels*? It is a national program that delivers nutritious meals to seniors who have difficulty accessing food due to mobility issues or other challenges. *Meals on Wheels* does not deliver meals to these seniors on the weekend, but folks don't stop being hungry just because it is the weekend. For many years now, SBPC volunteers have taken up the slack for about 30 seniors in the Spring Branch area on the 4th Saturday of the month. Lu Taylor takes the lead in this wonderful mission.



We have 2 routes and usually need 4 volunteers to split the delivery of all the meals. The 2 groups pick up the delicious, hot lunches from Pappy's Restaurant at 11:00 AM at 12313 Katy Freeway. SBPC pays somewhere between \$4 and \$5 for each meal, with Pappy's contributing the remainder of their costs. The delivery is your donation, which takes about an hour from the time you pick up the lunches to completing the route. There is usually at least one of the grateful recipients waiting to meet us outside even before we arrive!

Lu sends you the route and instructions a few days before your time. For those of you with kids, this is a great way to show them how they can help and serve people by doing something as simple as delivering a meal to them. What are Sunrise Centers?

In the fall of 2023, HISD established 7 Sunrise Centers to serve as gateways to connect families and students to services that can help close those gaps. They are now the district's primary source of noninstructional support.

Sunrise Centers provide a variety of free community support services tailored to homeless students and their families.

Services consist of essential resources including food, clothing, health care, mental health support, and job training, among other services, through partnerships with community organizations like Marian Park and Baker Ripley.

Sunrise Centers are located in high-need areas that operate as "one-stop-shops" for social service support.

HISD's data shows that in the first year of operation, the Centers served 30,900 families and data shows that those who went to a Center showed a 33% improvement in attendance or behavior.
