From the desk of Pastor Mark...

Dear Saints,

I am friends with a pastor who heads a church known as “The Church of New Beginnings.” I used to ponder the name of that church because the words “new” and “beginnings” seem to almost repeat each other. If something is “new” it can also be the “beginning of something different.” If something is a “beginning” it can also be something “new.”

In the end...great choice for a church name!

As spring creeps its way into our lives during the current days and weeks, we can all notice the new beginnings that occur all around us:

- Cold weather is beginning to change into cool weather;
- New plant growth is beginning to appear all over our gardens;
- People are beginning to spend more and more time outdoors.

New beginnings all around us!

This is also the time of the year when we begin to focus our biblical attention on the upcoming Lenten season. Lent arrives with Ash Wednesday on February 18th, and it concludes on Easter morning, April 5th. In between those two dates, so much happens that can be considered new beginnings:

- We are reminded that in Genesis 2, God created the first human out of the dust on the ground; we receive a slight layer of black “dust” on our foreheads as we hear the words, “Remember you are dust, and unto dust you will return.”
- Jesus showed us he had the power to heal the sick, the lame, the deaf – and the blind.
- Jesus demonstrated that everyone is loved by God, and that love came completely – even when we made mistakes.
- We receive a Gospel story of Jesus’ triumphant entry into Jerusalem, a story that all four Gospel writers chose to include using almost exactly the same details.
- And finally, after the empty tomb of Easter morning, all of humanity received an opportunity for a new beginning every single time we sin – but choose to return to God to ask forgiveness.

New beginnings indeed! Look for them everywhere around you and look for them within yourself too!

Amen!

Feed My Starving Children – a group of 15 SBPC volunteers went to Pines Presbyterian Church's Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) mobile Pack event on Saturday, February 21st! During our shift, we packed enough boxes of food to provide meals for 77 hungry children for an entire year. There was a job for everyone – we had runners, packers, labelers, weighers, scoopers, and more. From the youngest to the oldest, there was something for everyone to do. If you didn't volunteer this time, keep it in mind for next year! We all had a great time.

Blood Drives – we have three blood drives scheduled for this year, and the first one is coming up this month on March 29th. Save the date and reach out to Ashley Powell for more information. Become a hero for someone in need of lifesaving blood.

Volunteers needed for HISD Marian Park & Baker Ripley Sunrise Centers! Sunrise Centers are one-stop social service hubs where HISD students and their families can get support with everyday needs. They are in need of volunteers for routine pantry organization, routine storage organization, scout projects, diaper and formula donations, and routine help unloading food pallets before our food distribution.
